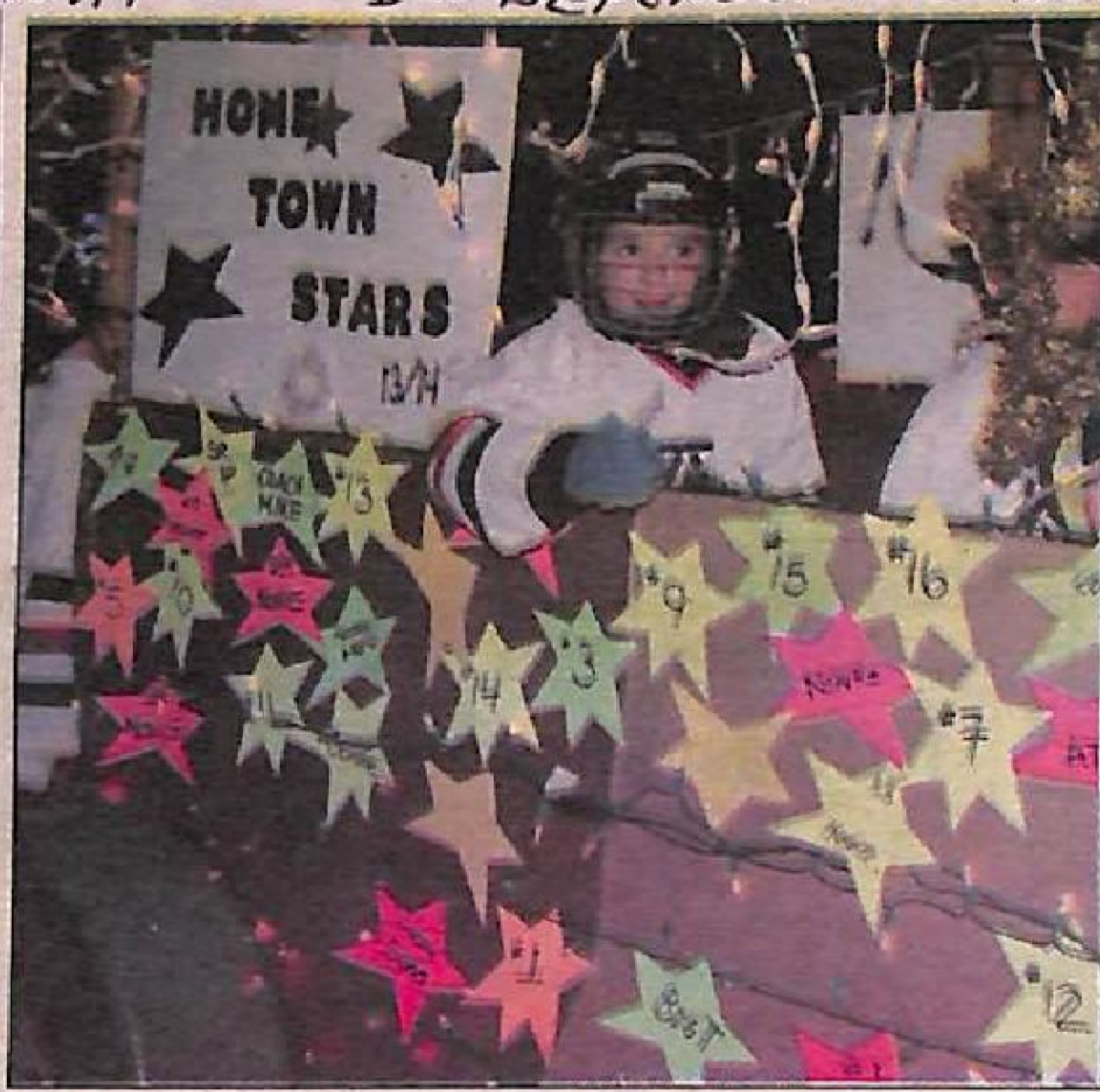


# Folks brave the cold to catch a glimpse of Santa

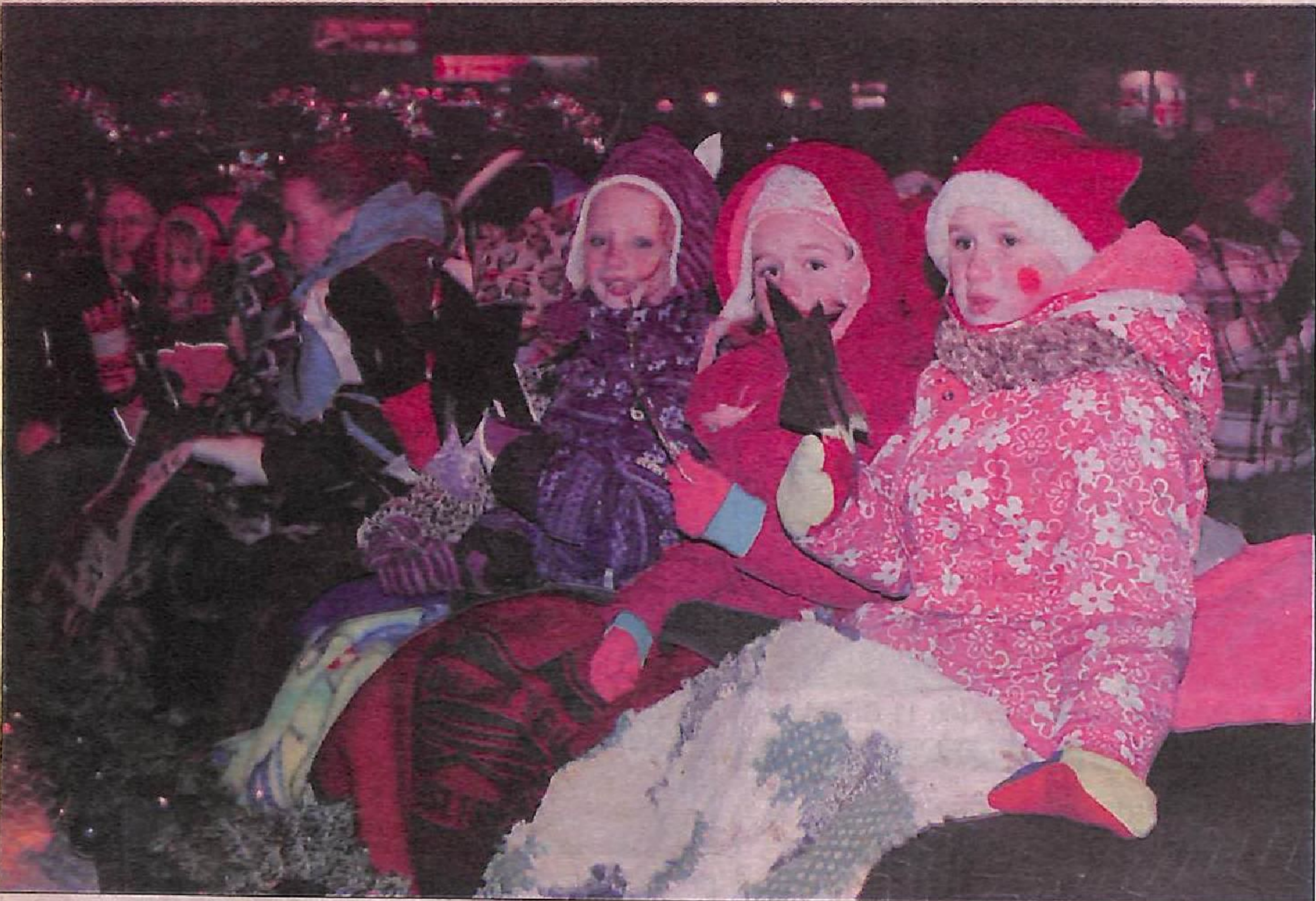
