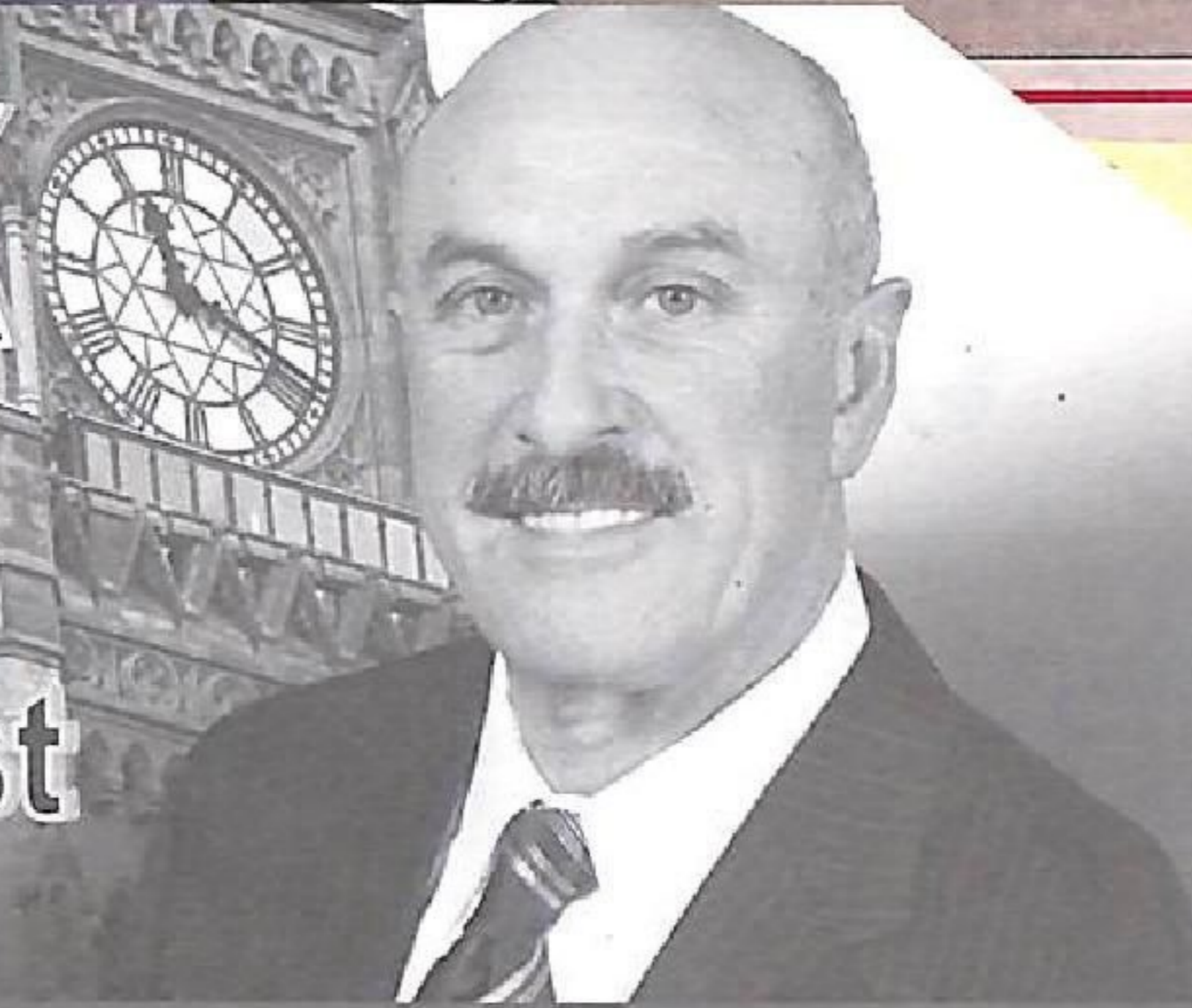

### Ruby B Mcculloch (1914-2002)



Ruby was nominated by Campbellford-Seymour Agricultural Society and was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2007.

She was lifelong resident of Seymour Township in Northumberland County. Ruby was also a well-known and active member and exhibitor at Campbellford Fair for over 60 years. She was also well-known for her work with the Campbellford-Seymour Agricultural Society and the Federated Women's Institute of Ontario. In 1992, following receipt of the Ontario Volunteer Service Award in recognition of 57 years of volunteer service, Ruby continued as an active volunteer in community organizations for another ten years. She received the Ontario Agricultural Service Diploma in 1983.
