## Not all fire department services are free

It may cost you if the Cramahe Fire Department is called out to your property.

Cramahe Township Council supported the recommendation of its Fire Chief, Brandon Northrup on August 1, updating the department regulations.

If you are a non-resident involved in a motor vehicle collision or mishap shall pay a fee and it won't be cheap - \$410 per hour per vehicle at the call out.

Cramahe has had a bylaw in place where the chief can bill residents or companies which have repeated false alarms when the alarms are caused by faulty equipment. The charge is \$410 and forget about the excuse that you were working on the equipment. If you didn't notify the department, or can prove it was someone tampering with your equipment, get out the wallet. And repeat offenders will not be forgiven.

If you are convicted of arson, you pay the subsequent inspection costs - \$350 plus \$50 per hour per inspector.

Any call outs for insurance or business inspections will be billed, but that is not new - \$50 per inspection plus \$75 for the report.

Tenants don't escape the collector if they have failed to comply with lawful requirements of the Ontario Fire Marshall and an inspection is needed. The cost there - \$350 per inspector plus \$75 per report.

Cramahe bylaws have allowed the township to charge the full cost of fighting a fire if a person has set the fire illegally or without a permit. The fire setter can be liable for all property damages too. The township can also bill when extra services and personnel are required to fight a fire.
