## Warkworth inmate sent to hospital after assault

NORTHUMBERLAND -- An inmate of Warkworth Institute has been transported to hospital after a recent assault.

Officials found an inmate who had been a victim of assault at the medium-security

federal prison.

The injured inmate was evaluated by staff and then transported to a hospital outside the facility.

Police are investigating the incident. There's no word yet on what spawned the assault or the extent of the inmate's injuries.

Warkworth officials and staff members were not injured during the incident.

The assailant was identified and Warkworth officials said in a news release "appropriate actions have been taken."

Warkworth Institution is in Campbellford and has a capacity of 537 male inmates.
