Warkworth out 29115 federal prison. inmate sent to hospital

NORTHUMBERLAND -- An inmate of Warkworth Institute has been transported to hospital after a recent assault.

Officials found an inmate who had been a victim of assault at the medium-security

The injured inmate was evaluated by staff and then transported to a hospital outside the facility.

Police are investigating the incident. There's no word yet on what spawned the assault or the extent of the inmate's inju-

ries. Warkworth officials and staff members were not injured during the incident.

The assailant was identified and Warkworth officials said in a news release "appropriate actions have been taken."

Warkworth Institution is in Campbellford and has a capacity of 537 male inmates.
