CRAMAHE TOWNSHIP -- A 19-year-old woman was struck and killed by a tree on the weekend.

The woman was cutting trees with her boyfriend on a wooded property near Castleton on Saturday, Nov. 21, said Northumberland OPP Const. Steve Bates. OPP were called at 12:50 p.m. to the property one kilometre west of Broomfield Road. The tree fell in an unexpected direction and the woman succumbed to her injuries on the scene, said Const. Bates.

"It's a real tragedy," he said. The woman, from Georgina, north of Newmarket, was visiting the property with her boyfriend.

Police ruled the death was not suspicious.
