Cramahe Dog Owners

This is a friendly reminder to all Cramahe dog owners to please keep your dog on a leash at all times when you are not on your own property.

As per By-Law 2009-01, Section 20 states "No owner of any dog shall allow the dog to run at large within the limits of the Municipality. For the purpose of this by-law a dog shall be deemed to be at large when found elsewhere than on the property of the owner and not under the control of a competent and responsible person. **Only an animal on a maximum two-meter long leash, escorted and under the control of such person will be deemed to be under control.**"

If you are caught without your dog on a leash, this is a ticketable offence under the Provincial Offences Act.
