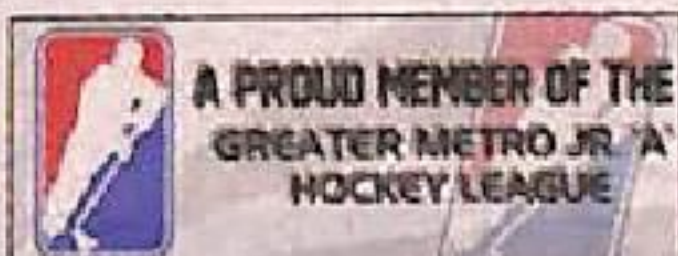

Phase 1-East Bank Sloping/Phase 2 Pit Floor Rehabilitation

The Township of Cramahe invites all interested parties to submit a quotation to the undersigned by 1:00 p.m., November 21, 2015 for the completion of Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the rehabilitation of the Little Lake Pit including the sloping of the east end of the Little Lake Pit and the rehabilitation of a portion of the pit floor respectively. Phase 1 is to be completed in 2016 and Phase 2 is to be completed in May of 2017. This project will include the following;

Phase 1

Sloping of the east side of the Little Lake Pit to 3:1 slope, including the addition of topsoil.

Phase 2

Rehabilitation of a portion of the pit floor.

All interested parties are asked to pick up the full tender document at the Town Hall prior to November 15, 2016 and a mandatory site visit is scheduled for November 16 at 1:00pm at the Little Lake Pit.
