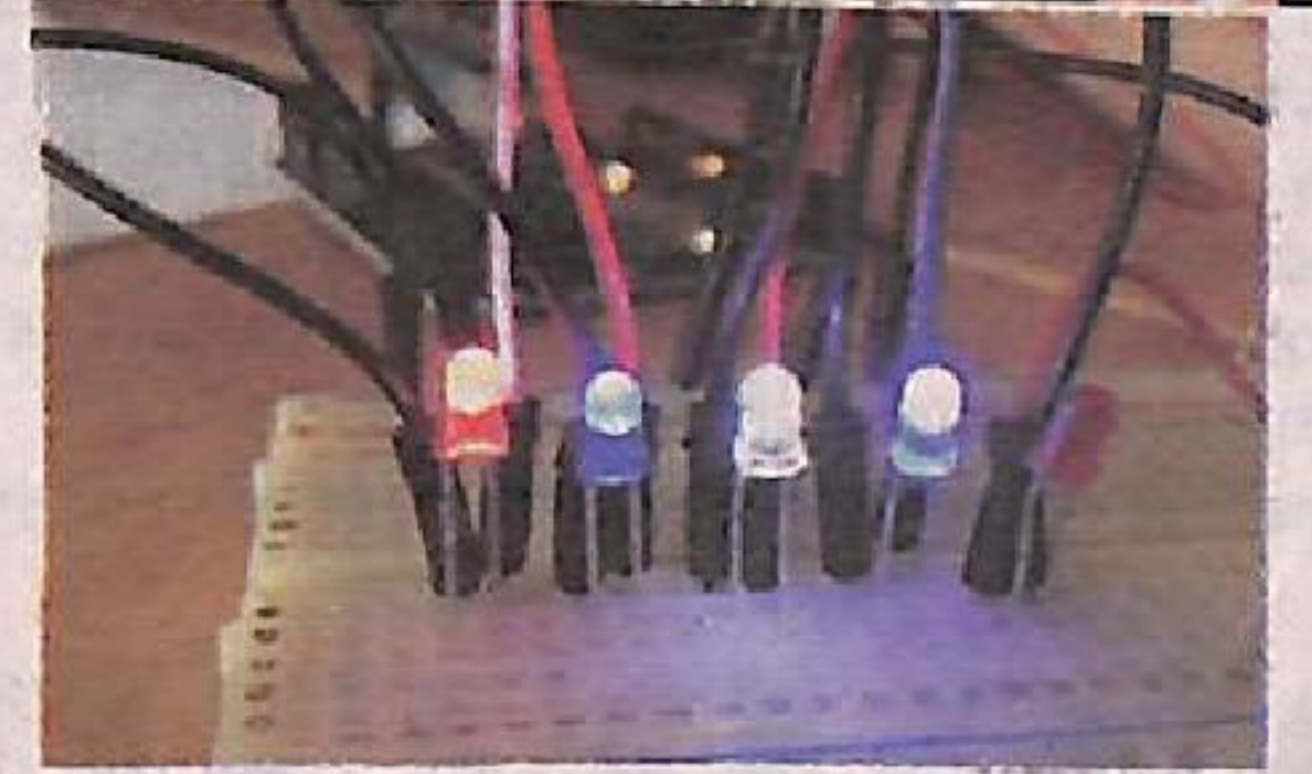
The countdown has started for the annual Colborne/Cramahe Santa Claus Parade!
