What Loomis is:

Loomis is a college preparatory school for boys covering the ninth through the twelfth grades. There are approximately three hundred and thirty students: about two hundred and twenty are boarding boys, the rest commute from their homes nearby. The faculty is composed of thirty-five members and seven non-resident assistants.

In recent years, boarding students have come from the New England States, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Maryland, Delaware, Virginia, Alabama, Florida, Michigan, Illinois, California, Mexico, South America, England, France and Norway.
