Adelaide Hoodless began her lifetime occupation of social service as a result of her son's death in 1889. In that same year she became one of the founding members and the first president of the Hamilton YWCA. In 1893 she helped organize a national YWCA, and was deeply involved in the establishment of the National Council of Women of Canada. Until her death in 1910 she was actively working to establish household economics training programs in the schools and universities of Ontario.
