Lord Tweedsmuir born John Buchan in Scotland, August 25th, 1875, the son of Rev. John Buchan. Historian, novelist and Governor-General of Canada from 1935 to 1940. Called to the Bar in 1901. From 1927 to 1935 he was a member of British House of Commons for Scottish Universities. In 1935 he was titled "Baron Tweedsmuir". He died in Montreal on February 11th, 1940. His library was bequeathed to Queen's University at Kingston.

Lady Tweedsmuir: Susan, wife of our beloved Governor-General, has written many plays, children's books and reminiscences. She was an ardent W.I. member in England, and made an Honorary Life Member of F.W.I.O. She advocated that our organization across Canada compile the histories of our local communities and villages.
