April, 2 - 1908 - Dr. Mason was to purchase from Jas. Evans, Omamee, a fire engine and hose.

At this meeting the band instruments were called in at once.

May 27 /08 - Harvey and Allair - That any councillor who is not present at any meeting by 8.30 P.M. shall be liable to a fine of \$1. - Carried.

Nov. 5 /08. Shaw - Irwin:

Mr. Stephens be appointed to light and clean the lamps of the town at a remuneration of 5¢ a lamp, per night, and also call on the Chairman of Roads and Bridges Com. each day for instructions when to light the lamps.

June 3 /09. Whereas in order to protect the tax-paying merchants of the town of Kearney ~~as~~ against Hunters, and non-resident peddlers, be it enacted that the Council of this Municipality of the town of Kearney shall impose a license fee of \$50. for a two horse peddler wagon, \$30, for a one horse peddler wagon, \$15, for a push-cart, and \$1 for a basket or pack.
