The first School Board, consisted of  
Messrs. Jim Woodruff, Martyn (Daddy)  
Corcoran, Harry Yonkey and J.T. Shaw. At  
this time there was just the one  
school consisting of two rooms. The Jr.  
room was held for a time in the old  
bank building. With an attendance  
of sixty to a class room, it was advisable  
to begin a Separate School. Father  
Flemming and Mr. Eddie Thomas already  
sat on the Board in the interests of  
the Separate School, and to them fell  
the task of organizing their school.

The average teacher's salary at this  
time was \$600.

Lower school was taught in

School, and also in the Separate  
School. Some of the students  
were fortunate to finish their  
High School education at outside  
centres.

Lower School work was taught in  
the Sr. Room of the Public School, and
