West Durham's car of produce for drought-stricken areas in the West is in Newcastle today and will be in Bowmanville tomorrow (Friday), so that local donors of fruit, vegetables, and canned goods might do their part in alleviating distress in Western Canada.

### Many Vegetables Sent To Aid Drought-Stricken

More than 250 carloads of fruit and vegetables have been shipped from the favored areas of Canada to drought-stricken parts of Saskatchewan, Rev. W. W. Judd, Chairman of the Joint Committee of the Churches for Western Relief, announced yesterday.

Mr. Judd expressed confidence the committee's objective of 500 carloads would be attained. More than 100 carloads have been sent from Manitoba and another 100 from the Eastern Provinces, he said.
