

SUSIE ALBERTA HARRIS

After a life devoted to her husband and family Susie Alberta Harris (Flett) passed away at the Community Memorial Hospital Port Perry on December 14, 1986 in her 80th year.

Born in Verlum Twsp. on February 6, 1907, she was the daughter of the late James E. Flett and Elizabeth Dunseath.

She spent her early years in Verlum Twsp. and moved with her family to Cartwright Twsp. in 1921 and in 1926 to Bowmanville.

Mrs. Isabelle Diamond died on Thursday, December 18, 1986, at Oshawa General Hospital, after a brief illness. She was in her 90th year.

The former Isabella Mcree Lee was born on September 4, 1897, on Hillside Farm on Conc. 9, Reach Township, near Greenbank, Ontario. She was the daughter of Sarah Akhurst, and Alexander Lee, a livestock breeder and ploughman of some repute. Her mother died shortly after Isabelle's 4th birthday.

After her marriage in 1921 to Ewart Diamond of Prospect, Isabelle moved to her husband's farm on Lot 14, Conc. 1, Reach Township. With her family's assistance, she continued to work the farm following Ewart's death in 1956. In 1966, after 45 years on the farm, she sold it and moved to Brooklin with her youngest daughter, Barbara. In 1978, she moved to Whitby.

Isabelle was a loyal member, in turn, of the United Church congregations in Greenbank, Prospect, Brooklin, and Whitby communities. Her life revolved around her family, her home, and her Church.

Oshawa man killed in tragic head-on collision

Durham Police say charges are pending after an accident last week north of Port Perry which claimed the life of a 31-year old Oshawa man.

The head-on collision occurred just before 6:00 PM October 13 on a straight stretch of Regional Road 2,

less than half a mile south of Honey's Corners (Concession 9).

Lionel Johnson of Oshawa was killed instantly. He had been a passenger in a 1985 Chrysler driven by Lawrence Woodcock, 42, of Guelph. The Woodcock vehicle was northbound on the Regional Road at

the time of the collision.

Regional Police say that a 1987 Camaro driven by David Sturgeon, 38, of Toronto was southbound when it hit the right shoulder of the road and suddenly veered into the northbound lane, striking the Woodcock vehicle head on. The force of the impact drove the Chrysler into the ditch and the Camaro then struck a second northbound car driven by Bonnie Mahony of Port Perry.

Regional Police say Mrs. Mahony was badly shaken by the accident, but not seriously hurt. Sturgeon was taken to Port Perry Hospital with broken bones and lacerations, while Woodcock was rushed to Sunnybrook in Toronto with serious head injuries.

Firefighters with the Port Perry Department had to use the Jaws of Life to free the injured men from the cars.

A spokesman for Durham Police said that because the Woodcock car had a baby seat, baby food and clothing, there were fears that an infant may have been in the car at the time of accident.

Police officers searched the area along the sides of the road, but were informed about an hour after the crash that an infant was not in the car at the time.

Although the accident is still under investigation as of Monday morning, police say charges are pending.
