

Obituary: Edmund Harris passes away at 82

After a lengthy stay in the Community Nursing Home, Edmund (Ed) Harris passed away at the Community Memorial Hospital on Saturday, August 27, 1988, in his 83rd year.

Born in Cadmus on October 12, 1905, he was the son of the late Frank and Victoria Harris

(Ginn).

He spent his early years in Cadmus, and moved to the First Concession of Cartwright Township with his parents.

On March 30, 1929 he married the late Susie Flett and started their married life on their farm, Lot 13, Concession 3, Cartwright

Township.

In 1973 they sold their farm, moving to Port Perry for a few months, then to their home in Blackstock. Unfortunately, he was unable to enjoy many years there due to ill health.

Ed enjoyed farming, then worked at Charlton Transport and later at the T. Eaton Co. where he retired from.

In his earlier years, he showed horses at local fairs and called for square dances at the many community showers and dances.

He enjoyed his family, grandchildren and visiting with friends and neighbours.
