Roads: Railway came as far as Orilla, mud and rocksover the hills - no going around, example from Kirk's cemetry to Coopers.

Oxen drew the wagons and ploughed the fields.

Church: Methodist, S.S. and church met in the Town Hall.

George lived on the old homestead. He died ,aged 92 yearsin the Memo-rial Hospital in Jan. 1951.
