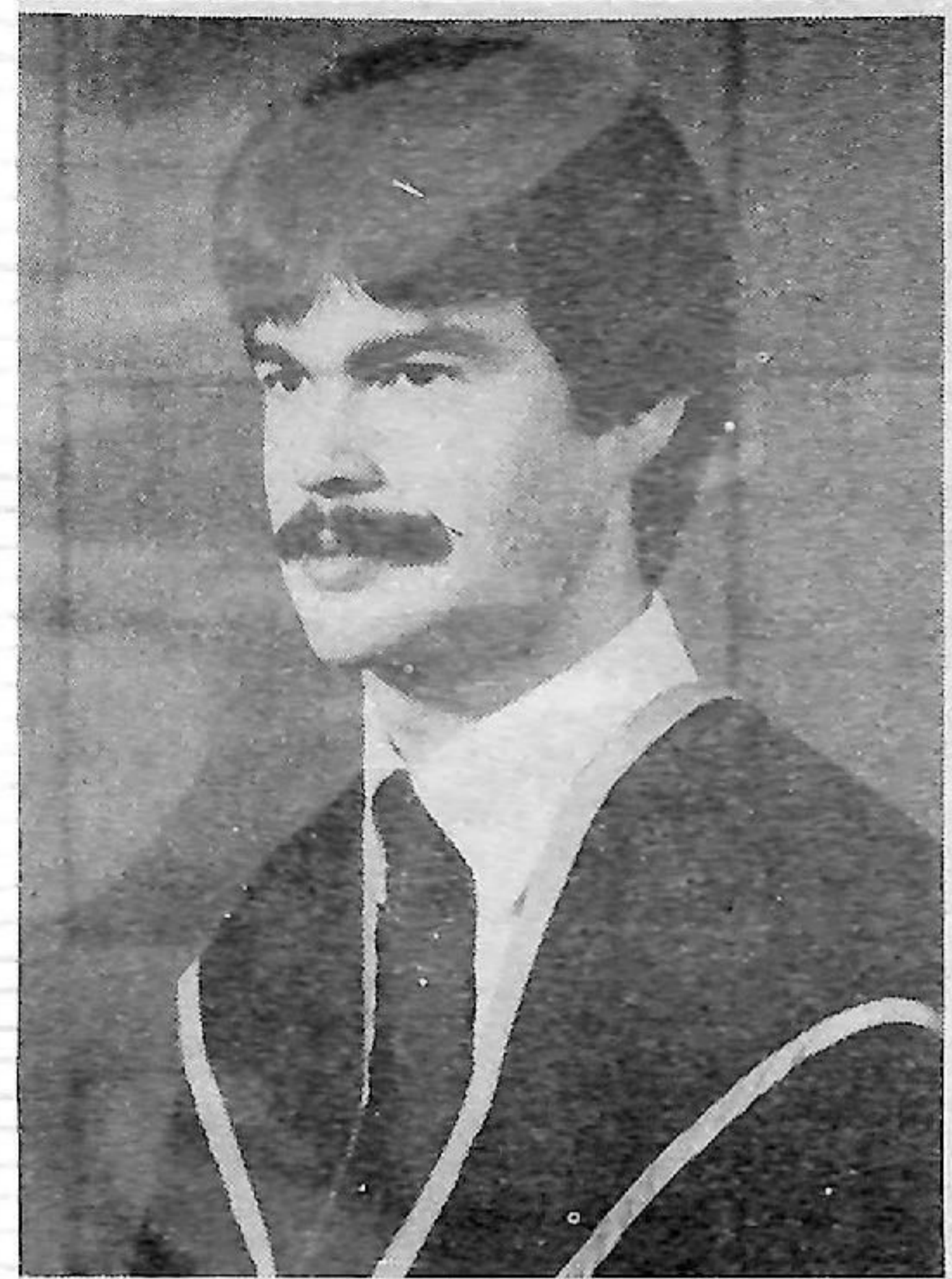


## ARBOUR DAY OBSERVED
