Fred Kenttala and his wife operated a 200 acre farm on the Kelly Lake Road. The farm is now owned by Kilpinen's but is no longer actively farmed. They lived in a log dwelling consisting of four rooms. The crops grown included wheat, rye, oats, potatoes and vegetables and hay. They also shipped milk to the City.

Fred and Emma Kenttala raised a family of nine children: Tyyne (Salo), Vieno (Moxam), Toivi, Ethel (Mannø), Viesti (Klusowich), Helen (Sirkka), Rauha (Maki), Kulervo, and Kalervo. None of the children are presently residing in Waters.
