Ruth was a charter member of the revived Women's Institute.

She served as president from 1929-1931 and was secretary from 1935-1938 and 1940-1947.

Ruth was a very devoted member and served the group well.

She was also a loyal member of the Lorneville Missionary society.

Ruth suffered from diabetes for many years but did not receive an early diagnosis. It eventually caused her death.

Her interest and contribution to this Institute might well have earned her the name "Miss Institute".
