Miss Lottie Brown, daughter of John Brown and his wife Eliza Childerhose, was born in the "Glen" - Westmeath Township, on the farm owned by Mrs. Osborne Collins and the late Mr. Collins.

She taught in Crozier's school (S.S. # 12 Westmeath) as well as in other schools of the vicinity. Later she worked for the Government in Ottawa, where she met and married Mr. R.F. Hicks.
