

At about the same time that Peter, Tom and James Dolan came to Torbolton, a cousin who was known as "Little Jack," also came and settled on the west half of Lot 3, Concession 2. With him were his mother and three sisters, Katie, Jane and Dollsie. Neither Jack or his sisters ever married but a nephew, Michael John Dolan, bought the south half of Lot 4, in the first Concession some ten years later and worked with his uncle, eventually taking over that place. About 1920 he bought an adjoining 50 acres. He married Grace McCaffrey of Venosta and they had five children: Anthony, Michael, Mary, Isabel and Monica. The father died in September 1944 and the son, Michael was killed in a car accident. Grace and the children carried on the farm for some time but later she married William Kavanagh of Goulbourne and went to live there. At the present time (1965) Michael John's 250 acres is registered under the name of Anthony, his eldest son.
