While speaking to Mrs. Lavalley recently I asked her what was the one great thing that won her all these awards. Her answer, in her typical modesty was "I didn't do anything, I just did what had to be done." These words left an impact on me and I strongly recommend The Royal Bank Award for this unassuming Great Canadian Indian Woman whose life is an example to all.

Mrs. Lavalley does not know of this proposal but I will tell her and hope you give it the highest consideration. Dr. Miles, a Toronto Vascular Surgeon knows Mrs. Lavalley well and is well acquainted with her social contributions and achievements, and readily joins me in making this proposal.
