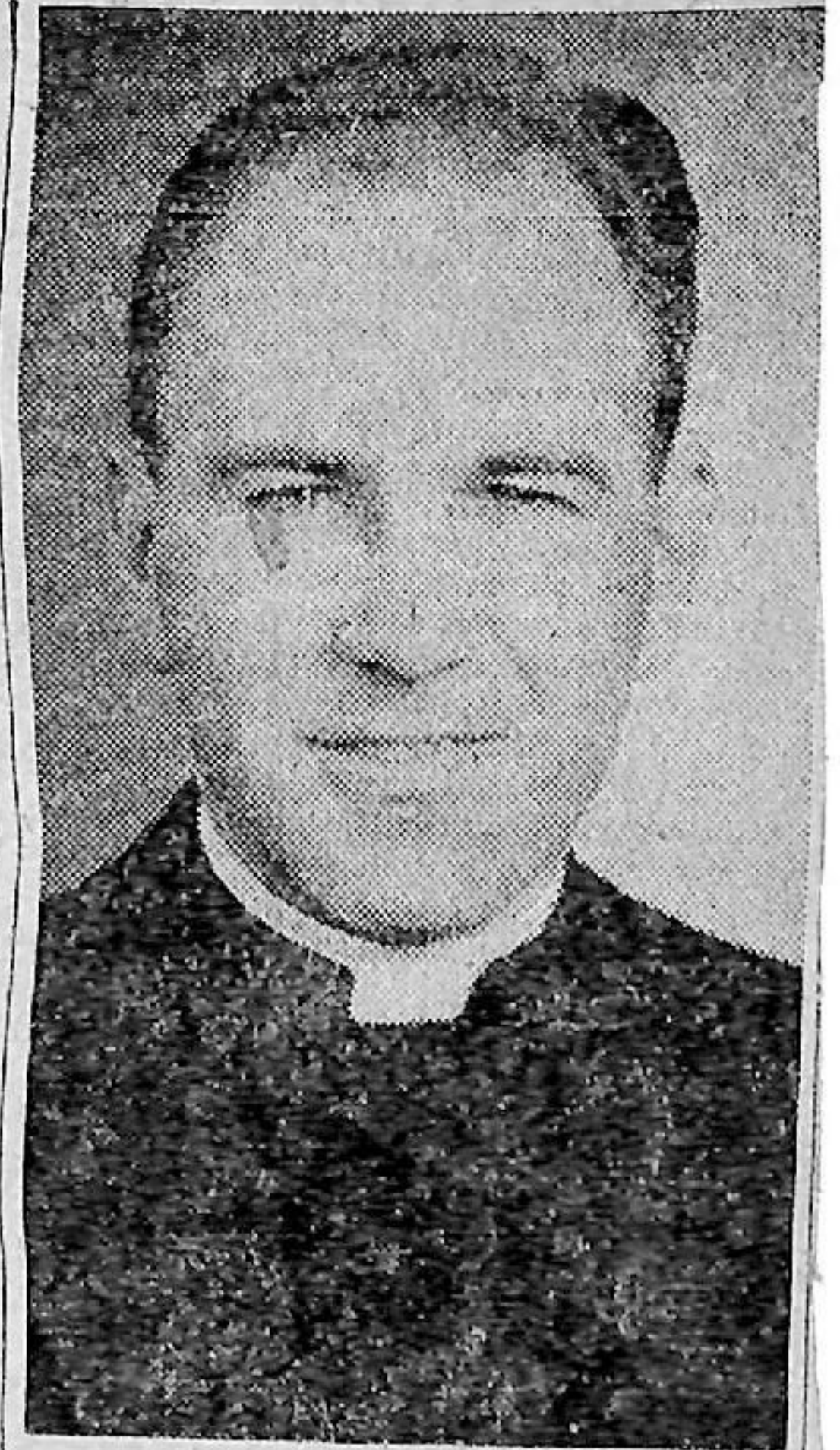

Reverend Norman Lange, Lutheran pastor at Rankin for three years, left today to take charge of his new parish at Woodstock and East Zorra. The vacancy at Rankin will be filled temporarily by a student from Waterloo Seminary.

Rankin Pastor Leaves Today For Woodstock

Reverend Norman Lange, who has been pastor of Grace Lutheran church, Rankin, for the past three years, has received and accepted a call to the parish of Woodstock and East Zorra and left today for his new charge.

Mr. Lange conducted his farewell services Sunday in the presence of large congregations and special music was rendered by a male quartette.

A native of Alberta, Reverend Mr. Lange attended University of Alberta at Edmonton and the Lutheran Seminary at Waterloo, graduating in 1954. The Rankin parish includes three congregations, those at Rankin, Bonnechere and Woito.

The vacancy at Rankin will be filled temporarily by Adolph Kappes, a student at Waterloo Seminary, and a permanent pastor will be called in the fall.
