

History of Rev. G. Cole's Farm

East half of lot 17 concession 3 of the Township of Horton
Our first records show G. Dunlop owned this farm
and Wm McDutty purchased it from him. As James
Allen held a mortgage on same he owned it for a short
time. Thomas Cole bought it from James Allan
Mar. 6. 1880. He cleared quite a lot of it and at one
time Potash and charcoal were made on the north
west side of it. John C. Cole son of Thomas Cole
purchased this 100 acres Dec 4, 1895. He and his wife
Elizabeth Jameson who had resided in Ross Township
for a short time, built a brick house as the house
formerly on the place was gone, he later built barns
and other out buildings. R. G. Cole their son acquired
the farm at the time of his fathers death in 1941.

● He and his wife Jessie Farguharson and their two
children resided here since 1920. R. G. Cole the
present owner and his son Robert G. Cole operates
the same.
