Myrtle Margaret Scott *Nov. 18/92* Obituary

Myrtle Margaret Scott passed away on October 27, 1992, in the Pembroke Civic Hospital.

Myrtle, the daughter of the late Thomas and Rachel Guest, was born at home on the Fifth Line of Ross Township in 1897. Her mother was the former Rachel Gourlay of Kinburn.

In 1921, Myrtle married

Malcolm Scott who predeceased her in 1980. She was predeceased by two brothers, Hiliard (Ada) and Leonard Guest and a sister, Hazel (Leslie) Davis.

Mac and Myrtle operated a farm for 30 years on the Cobden Road near the Zion Line. In 1940, they sold their farm and moved to Cobden.

Myrtle was a life member of the United Church Women, a charter and life member of the Pembroke Chapter of the Eastern Star, and a life member of Zion Line Women's Institute. She was also an active member of the Senior Citizens' Club.

The funeral for the late Myrtle Scott was held in

Grace United Church, Cobden on October 30 with the Rev. Paul McLenaghan officiating.

The pallbearers were: Keith Bulmer, Mac Coughlin, Alton Childerhose, Clarence Poff, Patrick Leach, and Sheldon Davis jr.

Interment was in the family plot, Cobden.
