(Not Incorporated)

with headquarters at Snake River, Ontario,
hereinafter called the "Proprietors," PARTY OF THE SECOND
PART.

Whereas the Proprietors at present operate or are about
to operate a metallic circuit telephone
system known as The Snake River Telephone Association,

extending from the corporate limits of the Village of
Cobden to points in the Township of Westmeath, County
of Renfrew, Province of Ontario.

Now this Agreement Witnesseth

That in consideration of the stipulations and agreements
made and entered into by the Proprietors as hereinafter set forth,

THE BELL COMPANY AGREES:—

the Bell Company at the charges hereinafter provided for, and to
provide the necessary equipment therefor at the Bell Company's
Office, at Cobden.
