

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH:-

That in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements made and entered into by the parties hereto, as hereinafter contained,

THE BELL COMPANY AGREES:-

1. To an interchange of telephonic conversations and messages between the subscribers and other patrons of the Proprietors System as defined herein and the subscribers and other patrons of the Bell Company and its connecting companies at the charges hereinafter provided for, and to furnish the necessary jack accommodation therefor on the existing switchboard in the Bell Company's office at Cobden, provided that nothing herein contained shall oblige the Proprietors to exchange messages through the medium of the Bell Company with other telephone systems operating in competition with the Proprietors.

2. To furnish and maintain at its expense necessary metallic circuits on its existing pole route from the Bell Company's office in the Village of Cobden to the corporate limits of said village to connect with the Proprietors System, provided not less than eight subscribers are paid for by the Proprietors as provided for in clause #3 herein, for each circuit so furnished, such circuits to be and remain the property of the Bell Company.

THE PROPRIETORS AGREE:-

3. To pay the Bell Company a switching charge of Three Dollars (\$3.00) per annum, payable semi-annually in advance, for each telephone set connected with their system, which amount shall entitle the subscribers thereof to local service
