

to or from the subscribers of the Bell Company's Exchange at Cobden, and shall also cover necessary switching of traffic between subscribers of the Proprietors.

4. To maintain their lines and instruments in good working order and make all repairs thereto with reasonable dispatch.

5. Not to place their lines on poles or other attachments carrying electric light circuits or other circuits of high potential character.

6. To place approved air gap lightning protectors, properly grounded, at the junction point where their lines connect with the lines of the Bell Company.

7. To adopt the Bell Company's standard code signals for ringing subscribers on party lines.

8. To adopt and observe, in the handling of interchanged telephonic communications, the operating rules of the Bell Company, and for all communications passing over the Bell Company's lines or involving the equipment of the Bell Company, to require their subscribers and other patrons to observe such rules and regulations of the Bell Company.

9. To collect all tolls for communications interchanged under this contract originating on their system, account to and be responsible to the Bell Company for its portion of such tolls, and remit promptly to the Treasurer of the Bell Company at its office in Montreal any balance due the Bell Company on receipt of account for such tolls so earned by it.
