Greeting

Whereas The Ontario Companies Act provides that with the exceptions
therein mentioned the Lieutenant-Governor of Our Province of Ontario
in Council may by Letters Patent under the Great Seal create and constitute
bodies corporate and politic for any of the purposes or objects to which the
legislative authority of the Legislature of Ontario extends

And Whereas by their Petition in that behalf the persons herein
mentioned have prayed for a Charter constituting them a body corporate
and politic for the due carrying out of the undertaking hereinafter set forth

And Whereas it has been made to appear to the satisfaction of Our
Lieutenant-Governor in Council that the said persons have complied with
the conditions precedent to the grant of the desired Charter and that the said
undertaking is within the scope of the said Act

Now Therefore Know Ye that by and with the
advice of the Executive Council of Our Province of Ontario and
under the authority of the hereinbefore in part recited Statute and of
any other power or authority whatsoever in Us vested in this behalf

We do by these Our Royal Letters Patent hereby create and constitute
