Through his efforts, he obtained legislation whereby any municipality could receive money in lieu of taxes on Crown property. His efforts also were the result of Mines Profits Revenue being paid to municipalities on Crown property other than municipalities in Northern Ontario. Prior to this Mines Profits Revenue was paid only to municipalities in Northern Ontario.

In 1963 he was appointed Chairman of the A.R.D.A. Committee.
This Committee was responsible for the study of many projects, including the study and development of the Muskrat Lake project. In 1964 and 1965, he represented the County council on the Upper Ottawa Valley Travel Council.
