WI marking its 100th anniversary

On February 19, 1897, there were 101 women at a meeting in Stoney Creek, Ontario, to hear Erland Lee and Adelaide Hoodless address the needs of rural women.

This was the beginning of the Women's Institute, which now is associated with country women's groups worldwide.

Locally, the Zion Line Branch has just celebrated its 75th anniversary, and the Beachburg Branch is celebrating its 90th anniversary this month.
