This is a brief sketch of a man who has resided on the family farm in Calvin Township all his life. This farm has been in the Wunsch name for 110 years. In fact the only farm in the township to receive a plaque for Calvin's Centennial in 1987. The requirements were that a farm had to remain in the same name for 100 years, and the Wunsch farm was 102 years old at that time. Henry and his wife Thora raised two children, Jimmy and Helen. They are grandparents to five grandchildren.

Henry served as a councillor for Calvin from 1960 to 1964. In 1965 he became reeve and held that post for twenty two years, retiring in 1985. He was also on the Nippissing & District Social Services Board from 1971 to 1988. He retired from the Board of Management for Casselhome in February 1995. He also received recognition from the Mattawa O.P.P. for services rendered on occasion.

Henry is well known in a large radius, in and around Calvin Township, selling beef, eggs, sheep, horses, hay and fowl of all kinds. If you need a dog, ask Henry. If you find a strange rooster in your yard, inquire of Henry! A good farmer, friend and neighbor, he is known as a man of many talents and much generosity.
