Funeral mass was celebrated at St. Anne's Roman Catholic Church, Rev. Maurice Gaudreault officiated. Interment Parish Cemetery.

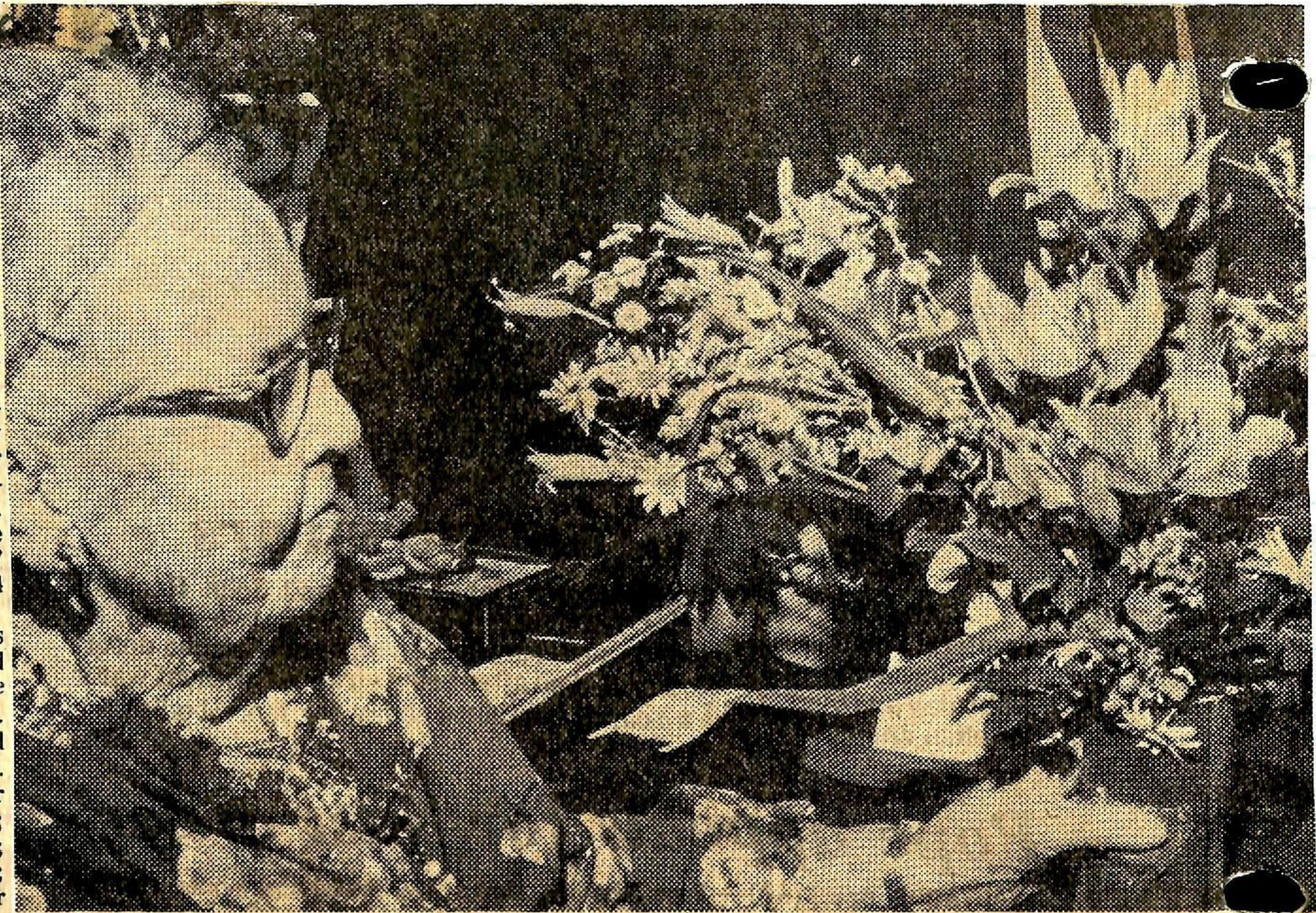
Born July 8, 1907 in Matawa, she was the only surviving member of her family. Mrs. Ouimette attended St. Anne's Church.
