

## SMALL BAZAAR ITEMS

PLASTIC SUMMER BAGS - Cut plastic bread wrappers round and round to make a long strip 1 inch wide. Roll into a ball letting it curl into rope shape while winding.

Crochet or knit two rectangles or circles the same size. Crochet or knit 2" strip to put between them, leaving the top open and let it continue to form the handle.

### POT HOLDERS OR RUG FROM NYLONS

Make wooden loom using finishing nails around the edge. Cut rings from the upper part of nylons to fit long side of loom. Those cut from the legs would be used on the short side.

Weave in place. Mix white nylons with coloured for a different effect, or use colour remover first then dye nylons in bright colours.

### INEXPENSIVE PICTURES

Find an interesting picture and a piece of wood, large enough to allow space around the picture. Cut picture out, and glue to board. When dry shellac several times, sanding between each coat of shellac. Decoupage or Mod Podge may be used instead of shellac.

### MOD PODGE ARTICLES

3 oz. of white glue            1 oz. water

Cut around pictures and arrange in place to get the finished look of article. These pictures could be used on a board for a picture, box, paper plate, etc.

Mix glue and water and apply to article to be finished, and let dry about 1/2 to 3/4 hr. Apply another coat to article then arrange pictures being sure to smooth from centre out to get rid of any air pockets. Let dry. Apply next coat over article and pictures. Do four or more coats and let dry completely, overnight. Spray with acrylic spray or shellac.

### BAKERS HELPER - RECIPE HOLDER

Plastic cover off spray can

Plastic fork

Plastic flowers

Plaster of Paris

Fill plastic cover 3/4 full of plaster of Paris. Before plaster sets place handle of plastic fork (back of tines facing you) in back of cover. Arrange short plastic flowers in front. Attach poem.
