DOUBLE DUTY DISHCLOTHS

Materials:

Dishcloth approx. 15¢ in quality Nylon net 72" approx. 39¢ yard

Line ordinary dishcloth on one side with hylon net. Cloths sell for 35¢ or 3 for \$1.00.

KLEENEX HOLDER

Materials:

Fancy cloth 10" x 5½"
Rickrack, bias or lace
Kleenex packet (5¢)

Fold 1 3/4" hem on each end $(5\frac{1}{2})$. Baste. On right side sew trim. Fold right sides together and seam at each end, leaving opening in centre. Turn right side out and fill with a package of Kleenes. They sell for 35ϕ to \$1.00.

PLACE MATS

l yd. white or pastel contac maper l yd. clear contac paper Dried flowers, weeds or pictures

Divide white contac paper into 3 mats 12" each. Do same with clear. Place white paper sticky side up and arrange dried flowers, weeds or pictures. Place sheet of clear paper over design, it is now washable on both sides. Sell for 75¢.

PLACE MATS AND NAPKIN HOLDERS

Use burlap or Scarlett cloth and fringe all four sides of each place mat. Divide the threads removed from each place mat into three equal parts and braid them into strips about seven inches long - then lie each strip in a square knot leaving a loop just big enough for a napkin to be pulled through.

BATH SALT CONTAINER

Take an empty soda pop bottle, partially cover it with different coloured felt, use a plastic foam ball for a head, amd ,ale eues, nose and ears out of felt scraps,

Add six pipe cleaners for whiskers, a ruffle around the neck, make of nylon net, and will with bath salts or bath powder.
