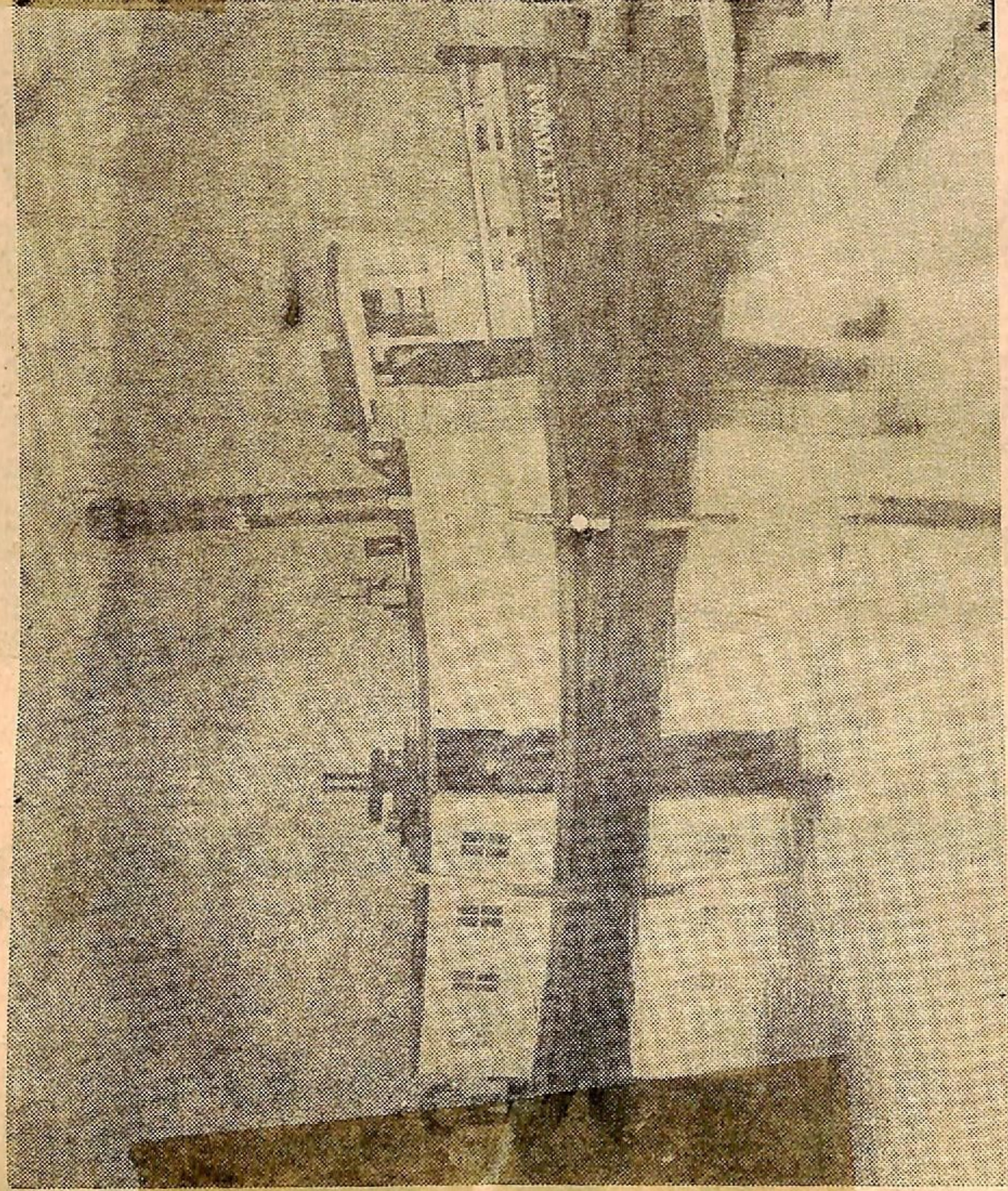


In the good old days
