Sir,

I have the honor to report upon
the survey of the Township of Caldwell, surveyed
under instructions from the Crown Lands Department
dated the 12th day of May 1850 -

On the 8th of June I left Toronto with as-
sistant and chairman, proceeding to Colling-
wood, thence by Steamer to the mouth of the
French River, thence in boats and canoes
up French River to Lake Nipissing and into
the Township of Caldwell.

On the night of the 22nd of June I obtained
an observation of Solaris on its eastern elongation.

I then commenced by retracing Salters Base
Line from the North Bay of Lake Nipissing
West. Not finding the five mile part, I
continued West and found the six mile
part from which I measured six miles to the
