Fall 1985 4-H BASIC BAKING

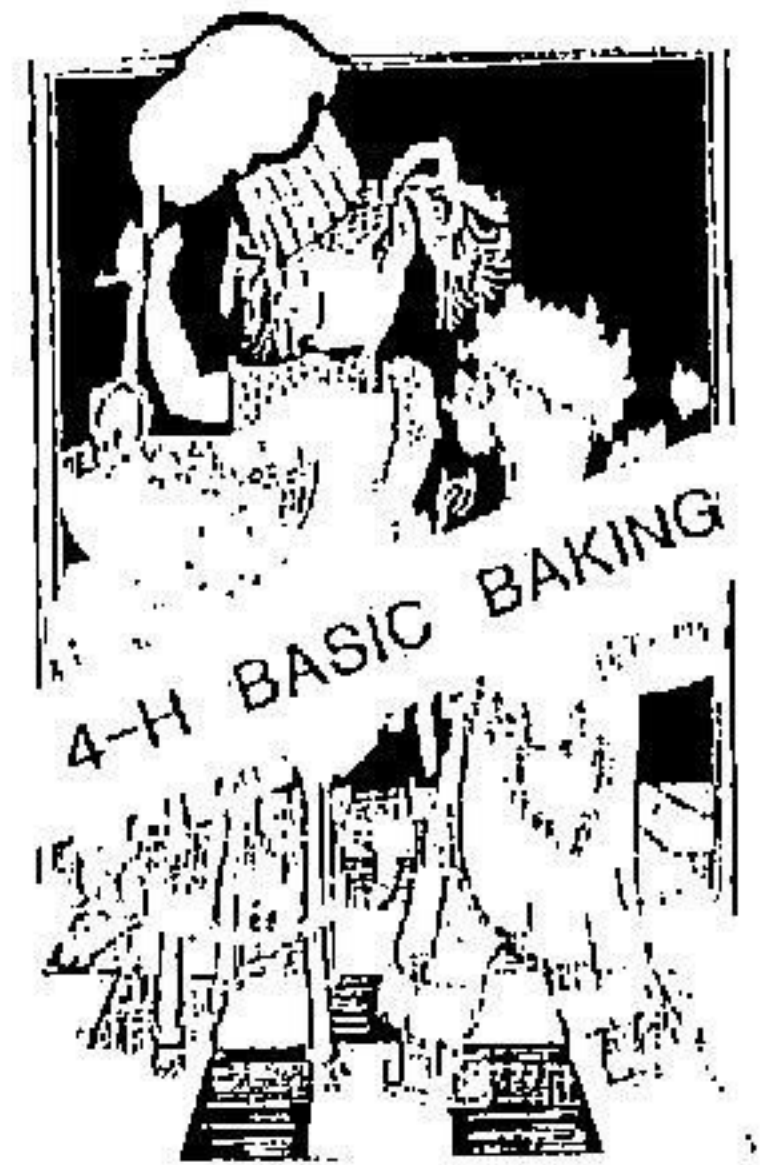

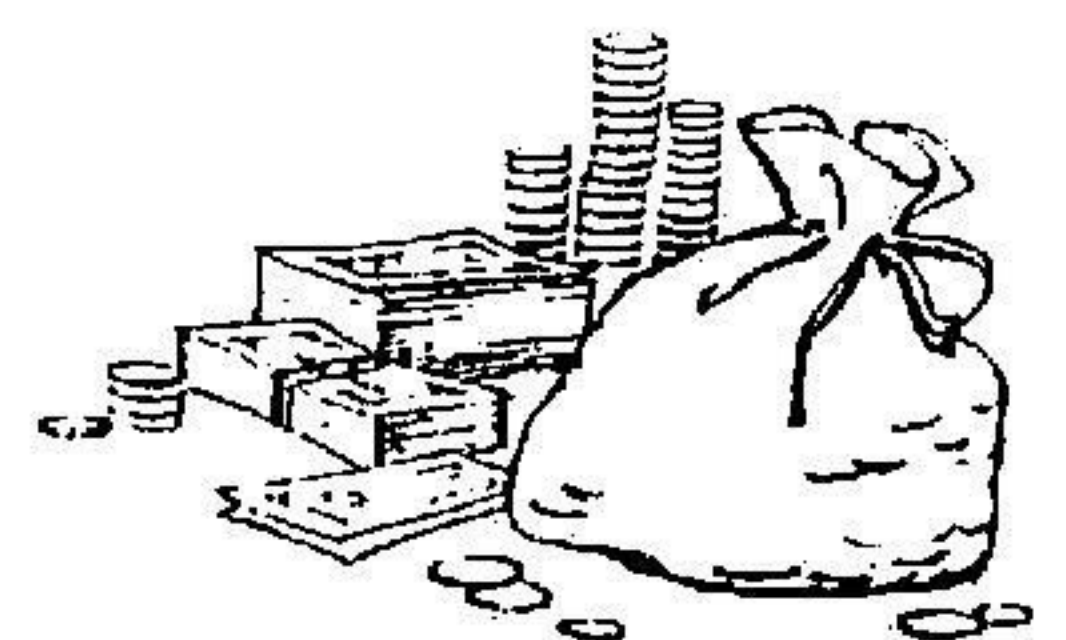
