Craven of New Liskeard then favored us with a solo and encore. An address by Miss Brydon, U. O. N. on Health Education was indeed an education that was of great value to everyone. Miss McVernand then gave a talk on Home Economics that proved of a great benefit to all. Mrs. Colloton taking charge of the question box again answered a number of questions, that were doubtful to the members of the Institute, to everyone's satisfaction. Mrs. Leng made a motion that we have the resurrection of the Provincial Health Nurse which was seconded by Mrs. Chrysler and carried.
