Sept 6.

The morning session opened at 9.15 with Mrs. Wm. Chrysler, Charlton, presiding.

The opening exercises were the National Anthem followed by the Institute Ode.

A Resolution from Cochrane District was read, - "Be it resolved that we ask the Department of Education to include a thorough course in Civics in the Junior High Schools, High Schools, and Collegiate Institutes to offset subversive influences among the youth of the Country".

It was moved by Mrs. J. Lotbians and seconded by Mrs. M. M. Clark that we have a discussion of this resolution. A discussion followed. Miss Clarke explained (1) That a Resolution should be an emergency, otherwise it should not be brought up (2) It should be worded properly (3) It should have backing.

A Round Table Conference on Responsibilities of Institute Officers and Conveners was led by Miss Clarke. Each member wrote on a slip of paper one question bearing on the topic. In opening the Conference Miss Clarke answered those questions. She then outlined briefly the duties of the different Officers and Conveners. She said Each Institute should have a Hand Book and it should be studied. Programmes should be planned in advance and given publicity, as members are more interested and come out to the meetings.

Mrs. S. E. Mc Cracken, Tomstown, addressed the Convention asking if the Institutes would help in the collecting of one and a half million labels of Clover Leaf Sea Food Products to be returned to the company for an ambulance. On a motion of Mrs. B. D. Warwick, and seconded by Mrs. P. M. Lachlan and carried, Mrs. Mc Cracken was authorized to receive those labels from the different Institutes, and to present the results
