The Stockholders met this afternoon at 1 o'clock, one hour before the general meeting, to discuss the advisability of raising the price of manufacturing Cheese, in Morganston, Cheese factory, from $1\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ to $1\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ per lb., and in view of the increasing expenses in every channel of the business the suggestion met with favor,

Moved by Wm Baringer seconded by Geo. Morgan that we raise the price to $1\frac{3}{4}$ ¢ and that after all expenses are paid, if any dividend exist, that it be applied toward the reduction of the debt on the factory.
