- Contracts, documents or any instruments in writing (except 66. trade contracts made in the ordinary course of the Co-operative business) requiring the signature of the Co-operative shall be signed by the president or vice-president and by the secretary, and all contracts, documents and instruments in writing so signed shall be binding upon the Co-operative without any further authorization or formality. The Directors shall have power from time to time, by resolution, to appoint any other officer or officers on behalf of the Co-operative either to sign contracts, documents and instruments in writing generally or to sign specific contracts, documents or instruments in writing.
- The Sual of the Co-operative shall, when required, be affixed 67. to contracts, documents and instruments in writing signed as aforesaid or by any officer or officers appointed by resolution of the Directors.
- The Co-operative may at a general meeting repeal, amend, vary 68. or otherwise deal with any rule or regulation passed by the Directors, and in that case no rule or regulation so dealt with or re-enactment thereof, shall have any force until confirmed at a general meeting of the Co-operative; but except as in this clause provided, no act done or right acquired under any rule or regulation shall be prejudicially affected by any repeal, emendment, variation or other dealing.
- The members of the Co-operative hereby approve and validate on 69. behalf of the Co-operative every action taken heretofore by the provisional Directors and members of the Co-operative.

## AMENDMENTS

Subject to the provisions of Section 156 of The Companies Act, 70. the Co-operative may by a two-thirds majority of the members present at any annual or special meeting amend, alter or rescind any of the by-laws of the Co-operative provided in every such case notice of the intention to do so shall be given to the members in the notice calling such meeting.
