Minutes of a meeting of Directors of The
Morganston Cheese Co-operative held at the home
of P. R. Darling at 8 p.m. on the evening of July 15,
1947.

The President, P. R. Darling, acting as chairman explained how the cheesemaker, Mr. John Fitchett wished to cease his duties as cheesemaker as soon as another maker could be engaged. On July 13, a couch was destroyed by fire in the house owned by the Co-operative and had it not been for the prompt action of the neighbours, the house would have been destroyed by fire.

Mr. Harold Steinberg of Wooler and son Douglas were present this evening and Mr. Douglas Steinberg stated he would hire to the Co-operative for a price of 23 mills per lb. of cheese manufactured and furnish his own supplies, 8¢ per lb. Whey Fat for separating the whey or for 21 mills for mfg. cheese plus the difference between cost of supplies in 1945 and 1947 and 8¢ per lb. Whey Fat for skimming the whey, in each case to be furnished with rent free house.

after some discussion, on motion of N. H. Doidge seconded by Percy Moore, it was unanimously resolved that the Co-operative hire Mr. D. Steinberg for the balance of the 1947 term at a price of 23 mills for manufacturing cheese, 8¢ per lb. Whey Fat skimmed. A contract was then drawn up and the meeting adjourned.
