

May 9<sup>th</sup> 1934

A letter was read from Hill Lake branch re Department Speaker's meeting to be held on June 7<sup>th</sup>. Arrangements were made for the meeting and it was decided that Miss Alexander stay at the home of Mrs W A Palmer. It was suggested that See write to Englehart and Hill Lake Branches, asking that they pay a portion of the cost of the meeting, as per instructions in 'Home and Country'. It was decided to discontinue the practice of collecting 1¢ per member at each meeting, the membership fee alone to be paid. The report of the 10¢ tea held in the hall on April 21<sup>st</sup> was given showing a profit of \$4.00. The following bills were presented, Auditor's fees \$2.00. Carpenter work on hall \$2.40. nails, tar, and coal oil 1.30. lumber 2.28, hauling lumber from Englehart 50¢. a total of \$8.48. Moved by Mrs McAuley second by Mrs Malin that bills be paid carried. A vote of thanks was extended to the Secretary for services rendered.

The meeting closed with the National Anthem after which a social half hour was spent.
