

# MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Date June 6, 1939 Place United Church, Cochrane, Ont.

Canadianization: Mrs. L. Hartford, Shelburne, Conventer.

Report showed such items as "Study of Colonization Scheme".  
A flag was presented to Reed Lake School. Recommended by  
some branches that Canadians be asked to put up  
flags on all national anniversaries, thereby showing  
more patriotism.

Peace Education: Mrs. J. Anderson, Monteth, <sup>Conventer</sup> Ont.

Report short - all branches had not reported. Articles  
on "Peace Garden", "Meaning of Peace", "Keeping" "Peace  
Scrap Books".

The new branches of Coppell, Kitigan and Cochrane  
gave reports of their work. Coppell had a discussion  
of Institute work; made a quilt, made aprons from  
flour bags; held a bazaar, raised \$39.<sup>00</sup> for funds.

Kitigan got books for library, doing helpful work.  
Cochrane just getting started, had difficulty in  
getting a place to meet, have settled that. One of  
their members attended local leader school in 1939.

Miss G. Grey, our guest speaker from Institute  
Branch, Toronto, Ont. addressed the meeting. She  
congratulated us on our punctuality in starting our  
meeting; on our six (6) new branches, and on  
our Standing Committee Reports. She spoke of one  
branch keeping Royal visit scrap book.  
Commented on the wonders of Radio, especially the  
broadcasts of the Royal visit, of the Scottish  
women to tour Canada, and to have a luncheon  
at Stoney Creek where the first Institute was  
organized. Miss Grey advised leaving the planning  
of the branch programme until after the District  
Annual - so the local leader can have time for  
her project.

She spoke of services offered by the Department (C.D.  
Branch) Speaker service for Districts also Local  
Leader Training School projects (also holding of  
Summary days) clothing and food projects - of  
which two are allowed if there are over 15
