

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

Date: June 5th 1940 Place: Cochrane United Church

Mr. Ross then spoke to us again, mentioned when a new Conventor comes in to be introduced by old Conventor. District Conventor's given names & address. Reports he sent to the Bureau. I suggested having Institute Museum in each District etc.

War Work Report was given by Mrs. Walker, who mentioned having a very active year. I 149 quilts from Newark, also mentioned there is an appeal for layettes from Liberated Countries, also Mrs. Service socks. Mrs. Walker moved reports adopted. Resolved by Mrs. L. Dawson.

Resolutions were read by Mrs. R. Dodds (as follows)

1. That education facilities be made available to all children of school age etc. etc.
2. That T. B. Clinics be established in Northern Ont.
3. That results of matriculation exams be released not later than August 1st.
4. That Prisoner of War Rations be reduced drastically.
5. That Clinics be established for early diagnosis & treatment of Cancer in Northern Ont.
6. Citizenship papers be granted to those coming of age when knowledge is acquired of Law etc.
7. That a fee of 1.00 from each Branch in the Convention Area to set up a fund for expenses to Conventions.
8. That Hydro be made available to all Rural Communities in the North as soon as possible.
9. That a Health Nurse be provided for Schools etc. in Northern Ont.

These Resolutions were moved by Mrs. Dodds. & carried. Mrs. Burrier moved Sec. by Mrs. Young that District Officers names be ratified.
