② "Therefore be it resolved that we the Dunning Branch of the North Cochrane District of Women's Institute, urge upon our Provincial & Federal Governments, the necessity of improving the lot of the North American Indian at once, by means of better medical services, a revised educational system, which would cater more to his needs, & finally the right to vote in this the country of his birth, and at the same time retaining his treaty rights."

③ "Therefore, We, the members of the White Women's Institute do petition the Dept. of Education & Dept. of Health in the Ontario Government to apply for and to give publicity to the above mentioned grant, urging that girls make use of the same and thereby perhaps stimulate the vocation of nursing."
