

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING

District Directors meeting. It was recommended by Board to have discussion groups listening to radio programmes and then contact radio stations as to likeable programmes. Mrs Mac Donald spoke of resolutions and said 79 had gone in from Ontario. She spoke of history of Canadian flag 1867 - red ensign accepted as official flag 1924 - recognized outside Canada 1945 - general use in Canada. She asked that it be displayed at all meetings and that etiquette of flag be studied; that hand book be studied and meetings conducted properly with close attention to motions; stressed the programme of Civil Defense, that there was definite danger from atomic warfare and that each home should keep a supply of canned foods on hand eat no uncooked food, nor drink unboiled water.

Mrs Mac Donald stated that District Secretary is not to give out names of Branch Secretaries to other organizations. She said it was duty of Branches to let Provincial Secretaries know of Branch Anniversaries and that Districts pay living expenses to Conventions.

Mrs J. A. Robinson, vice president told of her attendance to the Branch Presidents Conference at Guelph. The theme was "Start where you are with what you have." She emphasized that a motion must be made before discussion.

Mrs M. Ash, convener for Agriculture and Canadian Industries gave her report, seconded by Mrs Humphrey.
